The City of East Ridge will accept sealed bids for Rubbish and/or Garbage, Debris and Removal of Personal Property at 711 State Line Road, East Ridge, TN 37412. Bids will be received by Janet Middleton, City Recorder, on June 1, 2022 at 2 pm at East Ridge City Hall, 1517 Tombras Avenue, East Ridge, TN 37412. Mark all envelopes "Bids-711 State Line Road East Ridge." Envelopes not properly marked will not be accepted. Bids received after the appointed time will not be accepted. Copies of the bid specifications may be obtained at East Ridge City Hall, Mon – Fri., 8 am – 4:30 pm, except holidays, or at www.eastridgetn.gov. The City of East Ridge reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive technicalities therein and to award the bid in the City's best interest.

Purpose:

City of East Ridge municipal code requires all property owners to maintain their property under Title 13, and the 2018 International Property Maintenance Code adopted by the city. Item removal will result from identified violations of City ordinances by City code enforcement staff on the property.

Scope of Work:

The contractor shall remove all items as directed by code enforcement staff from front and rear of the property. Parcel is just under one (1) acre in size. Number of items at rear of property is unknown. **The City strongly suggests that all contractors visit site. Homeowners are living in the home.**

All items removed from the property will be discarded in their entirety without any salvage value.

The Contractor shall remove all hazardous material, as defined by the State of Tennessee and Hamilton County, in such a manner as approved by the State and County.

The Contractor is responsible for all fees associated with the proper disposal of debris, hazardous waste, tires, batteries, paint, etc.

The successful bidder(s), as Contractor, shall furnish all labor, trucks, tractors, safety equipment, and any other equipment necessary for debris pick-up, plus any other function that may be required to properly clear designated property. A list of all equipment available to complete the services of this contract should be included with the submission of the bid.

Approval by the City:

Solid Waste dump receipts for assignment must be attached to all applicable invoices relating to the specific receipt.

Provide before and after pictures accurately portraying the job, rubbish, garbage, debris, and personal property verifying work performed as indicated on the invoice.

Name(s) of staff members performing the work.

Number of hours worked by each staff member.

The city will request that a site visit with the contractor and a city representative be made to verify completion and compliance.

Pursuant to Tennessee State law, the attached **Iran Divestment Act Certification** must be completed, notarized and returned with the bid in order for the bid to be considered or awarded (Chapter No. 817 - hb0261/sb0377.)

Hours of Operation:

Work shall be permitted between the hours of 7:00 A.M. and 6:00 P.M on weekdays and Saturdays, or between the hours of 9:00 A.M. and 6:00 P.M. on Sundays. No Work permitted on Memorial Day, Independence Day.

Successful bidder shall finish within 60-90 days of being notified of successful bid.

IRAN DIVESTMENT ACT CERTIFICATION

EFFECTIVE DATE JULY 1, 2016

Chapter No. 817 (HB0261/SB0377). "Iran Divestment Act" enacted. Amends Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 12 by adding Chapter 12, which is to be known as the "Iran Divestment Act." The Act requires the chief procurement officer for the State, no more than 120 days after the effective date of this Act, to publish on the State's website, using credible information freely available to the public, a list of persons determined to be engaged in investment activities with Iran. It prohibits a person identified on the list from contracting with a local government and makes any contract entered into void. It provides that after the effective date of this Act, **every bid or proposal** made to a local government for goods or services, when competitive bidding is required, **must contain the certification stated below**, subscribed and affirmed by the bidder as true under the penalty of perjury. The Act allows the certification to be submitted electronically. **It prohibits a bid from being considered or an award being made if the bidder does not provide the certification below to the local government**, except under limited enumerated circumstances.

I certify, under penalty of perjury, that the following statement is true:

"By submission of this bid, each bidder and each person signing on behalf of any bidder certifies, and in the case of a joint bid each party thereto certifies as to its own organization, under penalty of perjury, that to the best of its knowledge and belief that each bidder is not on the list created pursuant to § 12-12-106."
