The City of East Ridge, Tennessee is accepting bids from experienced paint contractors to coat the new East Ridge Splash Pad at the East Ridge Community Center, located in the City of East Ridge.

To be considered for this contract, interested parties must submit bids on or before 2:00 pm, EDT, Thursday, February 16, 2023.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR BID SUBMISSIONS

All bids must be submitted to the city clearly marked "East Ridge Splash Pad". One Proposal (1) in digital format must be presented. Any interpretations, clarifications or additional information not disclosed in this bid packet and determined to be necessary by the City in response to questions, will be issued by means of addendum or addenda, which addendum or addenda will be posted to the City website, https://www.eastridgetn.gov/business_economic_dev.html, to all interested parties identified by the City as having received the bid documents. The Bidder is required to check the site to see if there has been any addendum or addenda posted for this Bid. Only questions answered and information supplied by means of such an addendum or addenda will be considered as binding.

Any responses received by the office of the city after the due date and time specified in this bid packet will not be considered. All corrections of any kind to any bid must be accepted (initialed) by an authorized representative of the Paint Contractor. All bids must contain a signature of an authorized representative.

SCOPE OF WORK/DESCRIPTION OF ITEM

Contractor will wash, prime, and apply two coats of UT-200 Series of Tuff Coat anti-skid and primer to the 2830 sq foot of the splash pad. The area is to be cleaned and prepped to manufacturing specifications. Contractor furnishes all materials and performs all the necessary labor for the completion of the project. All work to be completed by April 15th, 2023. Site location is 1515 Tombras, Ave East Ridge Tn 37412

1. A Statement of Qualifications, to include copies of résumés, professional and business licenses, certifications of insurance, letters of reference, and any other information deemed pertinent by the Contractor relating to its qualifications to perform the Project work.
2. Statement regarding the schedule anticipated for the project.
3. The proposed price for the completion of all work.
4. Bids shall include material specifications, narratives, and other materials, illustrating the scope, scale, and relationship of Project components. Documents to be submitted shall include, but not be limited to:
 - a. A detailed Project cost quote, completed and executed with all required information.

PROJECT CRITERIA

1. The City requires the coating of the Project to be completed within sixty (60) days from the effective date of a Contract to be executed between the successful Contractor and the City.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS GOVERNING THIS RFP

Rights and Responsibilities of the City:

- a. The City reserves the right to reject any or all bids, at any time. The City also reserves the right in its sole discretion to waive minor errors or irregularities in the bids or in the bid solicitation procedures or any submissions. The City additionally reserves the right to negotiate a change in the planned scope of services so as to increase or decrease the same and to award a Contract to the Contractor which is not selected as the top candidate by the City if it is advantageous to the City to do so. **THE CITY SHALL NOT BE CONTRACTUALLY OR OTHERWISE BOUND TO ANY CONTRACTOR UNTIL A CONTRACT HAS BEEN FULLY EXECUTED BY THE PARTIES.**
- b. The City reserves the right to reject the bid of any Contractor if the City believes that it would not be in the best interest of the City.

**IRAN DIVESTMENT ACT CERTIFICATION
EFFECTIVE DATE JULY 1, 2016**

Chapter No. 817 (HB0261/SB0377). “Iran Divestment Act” enacted. Amends Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 12 by adding Chapter 12, which is to be known as the “Iran Divestment Act.” The Act requires the chief procurement officer for the State, no more than 120 days after the effective date of this Act, to publish on the State’s website, using credible information freely available to the public, a list of persons determined to be engaged in investment activities with Iran. It prohibits a person identified on the list from contracting with a local government and makes any contract entered into void. It provides that after the effective date of this Act, **every bid or proposal** made to a local government for goods or services, when competitive bidding is required, **must contain the certification stated below**, subscribed and affirmed by the bidder as true under the penalty of perjury. The Act allows the certification to be submitted electronically. It prohibits a bid from being considered or an award being made if the bidder does not provide the certification below to the local government, except under limited enumerated circumstances.

I certify, under penalty of perjury, that the following statement is true:

“By submission of this bid, **each bidder and each person signing on behalf of any bidder** certifies, and in the case of a joint bid each party thereto certifies as to its own organization, under penalty of perjury, that to the best of its knowledge and belief that each bidder is not on the list created pursuant to § 12-12-106.”
