City of East Ridge Provides Update on Ongoing Residential Roadway Milling & Paving Operations

EAST RIDGE, TN – The City of East Ridge continues to make significant progress on its residential roadway milling and paving program, with operations actively moving through additional areas of the city following the initial phase announced earlier this month.

As part of the next phase of work, milling operations, used to remove the top layer of asphalt in preparation for resurfacing, will take place on the following streets:

- 553 – 547 Benson Drive (Partial Roadway)
- 7005 – 7104 Moreview Road
- 429 – 726 Frawley Road
- Roper Street (Entire Road)
- Scott Street (Entire Road)

- 1510 – 1500 Swope Drive (South)
- Clemons Road
- Pleasant Street (Curve to Oakdale Avenue)
- 1305 – 1216 West End Avenue (including Oakdale Avenue intersection)
- 5440 – 5495 Oakdale Avenue
- 5312 – 5319 Oakdale Avenue
- 5303 Marion Avenue to Altamaha Street
- 5401 – 5427 Marion Avenue to West End Avenue
- 5200 Block of Weaver Street
- South St. Marks Avenue to Weaver Street

April 20th – 24th, 2026:

- Belvoir Avenue (Fountain Avenue to The Terrace)
- Spriggs Street
- Greenbriar Road (Prigmore Road to McBrien Road)
- 2107 – 2105 Wren Road
- Claremont Court
- Gleason Drive (Gleason Terrace to Donaldson)
- Franklin Place (3 to 13 Summit Avenue)
- Greens Lake Road (1512 to Stateline Road)
- 1500 – 1400 Block of Greens Lake Road
- 1612 – 1623 South Rugby Place

Work will continue progressing westward and south of Ringgold Road in the coming weeks as crews move efficiently through the project areas.

Residents in affected areas should expect temporary traffic delays, lane closures, and increased construction activity. Motorists are encouraged to use caution in work zones, reduce speeds, and seek alternate routes when possible.

Additionally, residents are asked to avoid on-street parking in impacted areas during active construction to allow crews to complete work safely and efficiently.

The City of East Ridge appreciates the community's continued patience and cooperation as these improvements are made to enhance roadway conditions and overall infrastructure throughout the city.
